Terms of reference:

This is a committee of Faculty Board.

The Committee is responsible for the operation and promotion of the graduate studies coursework programme of the Faculty.

The particular functions of the Committee include:

- *supervising the admission of students to graduate programmes*
- *reviewing and recommending subjects for inclusion in the graduate programme*
- *approving assessment regimes for graduate units*
- *reviewing the annual offerings of units in the graduate programme*
- *determining applications for reduction and extension of the period of candidacy*
- *advising the Dean on applications for graduate scholarships in Law tenable within the University.*

More generally, the Committee is concerned with the development and refinement of all matters of policy concerned with graduate studies within the Faculty.
